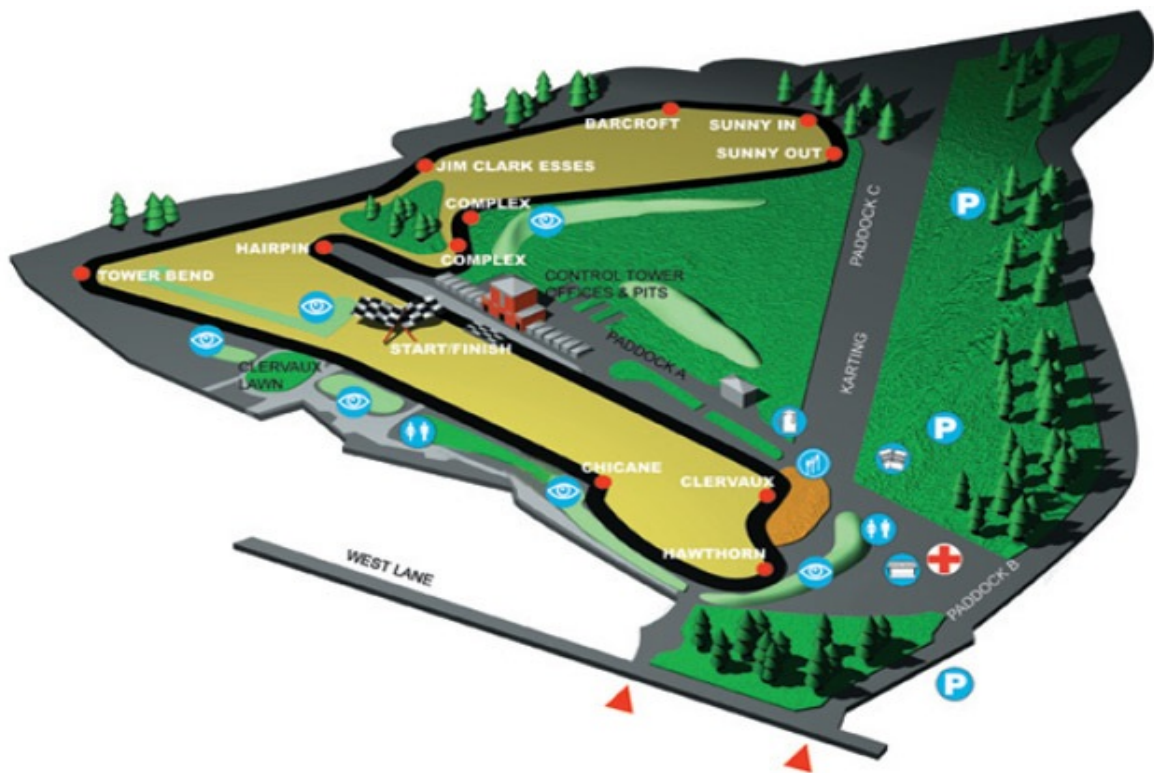


IAM Rider Skills Days

Croft Circuit

Thursday 8th May 2014

Croft Circuit in North Yorkshire is a new circuit for IAM Rider Skills Days. Set in beautiful countryside a few miles south of Darlington this 2.1 mile track has some challenging corners and extensive straights which give a really broad spectrum of experiences to help riders develop their skills.



This full day event offers sessions of circuit riding under the guidance of an experienced IAM instructor interspersed with theoretical input to help you enhance your riding. The instructor will develop your observations and your techniques of bike control so that you are able to make rapid and smooth laps of the circuit. You will work on positioning, braking, gear choice and acceleration technique. Repeated laps of the same circuit allow you to experiment with different variations of approach, and demonstrate how critical the right choice is to making the ride feel absolutely right. It doesn't have to be done at fearsome speeds. You can enjoy the Skills Day at your own pace and your instructor will work with you in whatever way suits you best. After

booking, we shall ask to you for details of your previous experience so that we can ensure you get instruction at a level most beneficial to you. The circuit environment allows you to experience the subtleties of your bikes handling. You are in a controlled space. The usual hazards associated with the public roads are entirely absent. The setting for Skills Day training is unique.

IMPORTANT NOTES

The booking and payment arrangements for this event are very specific and to help us you must follow them closely. There have been occasional difficulties with bookings for previous events when the dedicated event administrator has been unaware of bookings, a situation which we wish to avoid. **Staff at IAM House cannot accept bookings in any circumstances.** The event administrator is David Stringer, who **MUST** receive all applications and whose acknowledgement of booking **ONLY** will be accepted as proof of a valid place being allocated to you.

1. You can reserve your place provisionally either by phone, followed by **prompt** submission the booking form, or simply complete and send the booking form by e-mail attachment or post.
2. Upon receipt of the booking form your place will be reserved for you and the booking will be acknowledged by e-mail. You must advise the event administrator if the acknowledgement appears to be at all delayed, relative to the means by which you submitted it, in case your application has not been received for some reason. Every attempt will be made to acknowledge booking forms within 24 hours of receipt.
3. Booking forms received after the event is fully booked will be acknowledged as such and placed on a reserve list. A place will be offered to you in strict order of receipt should an accepted booking be cancelled. No payment will be taken until such place is offered and accepted.
3. Payment must be made by debit or credit card to IAM House in Chiswick. When your booking has been confirmed, you will receive an e-mail giving a specific window by date and time in which you must call a dedicated number at IAM House to make your payment. The staff will have a list to hand of the bookings for which payment is expected. You must advise in advance if you cannot make contact to pay in the given period, otherwise your place may be offered to someone on the reserve list. It is expected that the date for payment to be made will be in February 2014 and you will be advised of the payment window no less than 2 weeks prior to the date.
4. Joining instructions and detailed information will be circulated to the participants, by e-mail, about 3 weeks before the event.

NOISE

There are noise restrictions at Croft which must be adhered to. A breach of the noise limits could result in the entire event having to be curtailed. In no

circumstances will the IAM will allow any bike which is likely to breach the limits to be taken onto the circuit.
